

2023 TSJCL SWEEPSTAKES INFORMATION

The following Sweepstakes points will be awarded for the TSJCL State Latin Competition:

ACADEMIC CONTESTS

(Contest Codes 01 – 23):

- 1st Place – 14 points
- 2nd Place – 12 points
- 3rd Place – 10 points
- 4th Place – 8 points
- 5th Place – 6 points

CLASSICAL CIV. CONTESTS

(Contest Codes 50 – 82):

- 1st Place – 12 points
- 2nd Place – 10 points
- 3rd Place – 8 points
- 4th Place – 6 points
- 5th Place – 4 points

PENTATHLON

(Contest Code 99):

- summā cum laude** – 4 points
- maximā cum laude** – 3 points
- magnā cum laude** – 2 points
- cum laude** – 1 point

There will be four divisions for Sweepstakes:

Exclusively designated for Middle School or Lower School Programs:

- Silver Division
 - Academic contest scores for levels 1/2A, 1/2B, 1, and 2 count for sweepstakes.
 - Classical civilization contest scores count for sweepstakes.
 - Pentathlon scores for levels 1/2A through level 2 count for sweepstakes.

The following divisions are exclusively designated for High School or Upper School Programs:*

- Red Division: Schools with ~9 or fewer students attending the 2023 TSJCL State Convention
- Gold Division: Schools that bring between ~10 & ~29 students to the 2023 TSJCL State Convention
- Purple Division: Schools that bring ~30 or more students to the 2023 TSJCL State Convention

**The numbers used here for sweepstakes placement are meant as guidelines only. The final sweepstakes division placement for each school will be determined by the state chairs after final registration numbers have been tabulated in order to ensure balanced sweepstakes divisions.*

For all three High School / Upper School divisions:

- Academic contest scores for levels 1 through 5+ count for sweepstakes.
- Classical civilization contest scores count for sweepstakes.
- Pentathlon scores for levels 1 through level 5+ count for sweepstakes.

Schools with both middle school and high school students must register in separate divisions (i.e., 6th – 8th grade students must be entered in the Silver Division and 9th grade and higher must be entered in one of the high school divisions). This means that you have to use two different school codes and register two separate chapters.
